

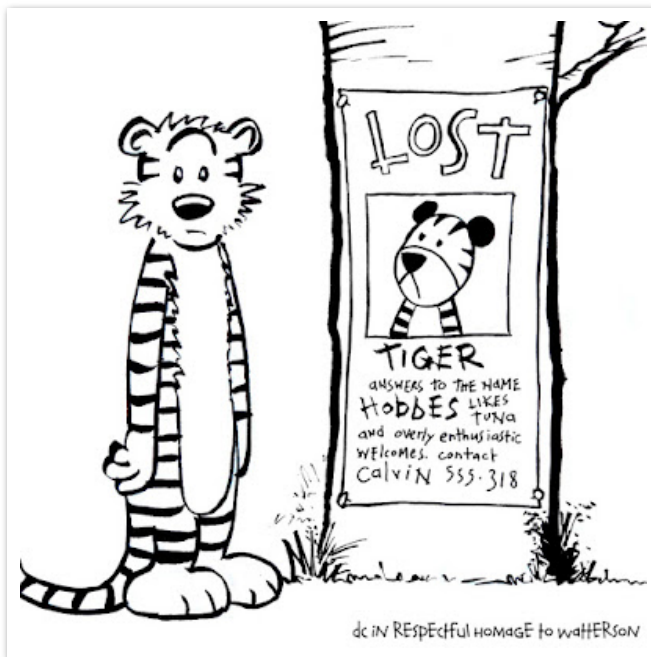

Or perhaps something, or someone, that **WAS** lost is **found** ... by you. What happens next?

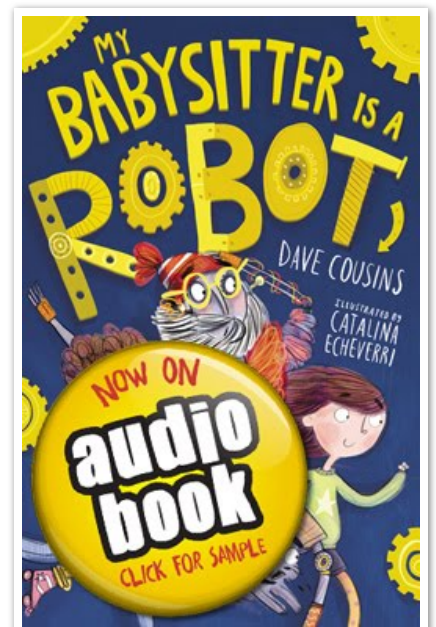
P.S. I wanted to do a picture for this one and thought of a *lost pet poster* – which got me thinking about cats, which of course led me to my favourite cartoon feline –

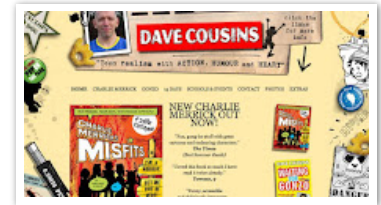
